School Uniform

School uniform is:

- grey trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore;
- white shirt or polo shirt;
- grey jumper, sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece;
- gingham summer dress.

Jewellery

Jewellery is not to be worn to school with the exception of **stud** earrings.

All earrings must be removed for PE, dance and gymnastics. If your child has difficulty removing their earrings we suggest that they don't wear them for school on PE, dance or gymnastics days.

PE Uniform

PE uniform which must be worn for PE, dance and gymnastics is:

- light blue polo top;
- plain black shorts, joggers or leggings;
- trainers or sandshoes for PE.

Head lice

Long hair must be tied back as this helps to reduce the spread of head lice.

Please check your child's hair weekly for head lice using the <u>wet combing</u> <u>method</u>. If your child has head lice the whole family must be checked.

If you need advice on dealing with head lice the school nurse, Helen, is available every Tuesday afternoon.
